

THE JUDSON HEALTH CENTER

The Judson Health Center began its life in January 1921 in the basement of Judson Memorial Church. In July 1922 it moved next door into Judson House, where it occupied most of the building until the summer of 1950. The Center continues to operate its clinics on Spring Street in New York City, still providing services to newly arrived immigrants.
